Trial Instructions and Guidelines

Please read carefully. The covid-19 waiver, included with this premium, must be signed before your dog can run. This waiver is also located on the CDTC's web site or on <u>kwagility.com</u>.

With the safety of exhibitors, volunteers, and staff, and adherence to State and CDC requirements and guidelines, the CDTC has put in place the following procedures for our agility trial at the Piedmont KC on Oct 9, 10, & 11, 2020.

- If you do not feel you can comply with these requirements, please do not enter our not enter our trial. You are required to sign the covid-19 waiver included with this premium and enclose it with your entry. You may not run if we do not have a signed waiver.
- 2. Rules and guidelines here are subject to change. Updates will be provided prior closing.
- 3. Social distancing of 6 ft will be in practice at all times. There will be no congregating around the rings or ribbons.
- 4. There will be no indoor crating. Please plan to crate at your tent or vehicle and provide shade for your dogs.
- 5. There will be no hospitality provided. Please bring your own food and water. Sorry, but no MACH cakes either. We will have a hose to cool your dog down.
- 6. Masks are required when you can not social distance. We will encourage you to run with a mask, but it is your choice. We will expect you to wear a mask when entering and leaving the rings.
- 7. Walkthroughs will be limited to less than 25 exhibitors. You **must** wear a mask during the walkthrough.
- 8. We will have wash stations at each ring.
- 9. Bathrooms are in the building and you must wear a mask when you use them.
- 10. Workers **must wear a mask.**
- 11. The courses will be posted on the trial secretary's website, <u>www.kwagility.com</u>, after 6pm on the evening prior to each day's trial. We will also have the courses posted in several places. Please use your cell phone or camera to take pictures of them. There will be no paper course maps.
- 12. Please bring your own pen to mark gate sheets or record results.
