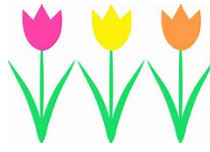

## DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs with a PAL, ILP or AKC Canine Partners Listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. **Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after the Closing Date/Time:** CDTC and GCOC are

offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 75 entries will be placed on the list. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00pm April 8, 2020. Any entries withdrawn by 6:00pm April 20, 2020, will be replaced by a wait-listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list by April 20, 2020, will receive a full refund.

## DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

**From Charlotte, NC:** Take I-77 South, take exit 18 onto SR-277, take ramp onto I-20W, take exit 64A onto I-26 East – OR - Take I-77 South around Columbia until it ends at I-26, take the right fork onto I-26 West

**From Florence, SC:** Take I-20 West to I-26 East

**From Atlanta & Augusta:** Take I-20 East to US Route 1 North to I-26 East

Once on I-26 proceed to exit 113 (Airport Exit / SC Route 302). Go 4.2 miles west on Route 302 (towards the airport). Turn left on Ramblin Road, Go 1 block and turn right on Oak Street (at the school zone sign). Go approximately 1 block, and the trial site will be on your left across from the fire station

## NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete. You must notify the trial secretary of any data entry errors which appear on your confirmation. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after entries close, except for move-up provisions as specified on page 8 of this premium and also except for regulation Chapter 1, Section 21.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks. Refunds of less than \$5 will not be made. Entries which are incorrect, illegible, or incomplete will not be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor. Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement portion attached are not acceptable.

THE SAFETY OF THE DOGS IS OUR PRIMARY CONCERN. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. PUPPIES UNDER 4 MONTHS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED FROM THE GROUNDS.

The Greater Columbia Obedience Club and the Lexington County Recreation & Aging Commission assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ALLOWED TO COMPETE IN AGILITY TRIALS and may be withdrawn after closing. Entry fees less \$5 per run (administrative cost) will be refunded at the request of the exhibitor. Entry fees less \$10 per run (administrative cost) for

dogs injured (or for unexpected death) after the closing date will also be refunded. All requests must be accompanied by a veterinarian's certification presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**BE A RESPONSIBLE DOG OWNER AND EXHIBITOR. Pick up after your dog on the grounds & at your hotel site. Encourage others to do the same.** All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The AKC Regulations for Agility Trials contains complete details concerning Dogs Eligible to enter, obstacles which will be used, and descriptions of the Classes Offered. Copies of the regulations may be obtained from the AKC website (<http://www.akc.org>).

### **HOW TO ENTER THE TRIAL**

Checks should be made out to the Greater Columbia Obedience Club or GCOC. **PLEASE DO NOT STAPLE your check to the entry form.** Entry fees include AKC recording fees of \$3.50 for the 1<sup>st</sup> run and \$3 for each additional run of the same dog per day. Envelopes containing entries for more than 10 dogs shall be returned. If you include a legible email address, we will notify you of the acceptance status of your entry. Dogs may not switch between Regular and Preferred classes within the weekend. PLEASE - MAKE SURE THAT YOU ADD THE TRIAL SECRETARY'S ADDRESS ([karen-w@msn.com](mailto:karen-w@msn.com)) to your safe senders list. Entries close at the address of the Trial Secretary on April 8, 2020, at 6:00 PM ET, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. Entries received prior to the opening date and time are invalid entries and will be returned.

**Electronic Entries** – You may enter these trials online at <http://www.akc.org/AgilityEntry> and pay by credit card. Please follow the instructions on the web site to use your 'My AKC' account to enter this event. **During the first 48 hours after opening, the limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 88 online entries and 262 paper. If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.**

**NOTE: Hand Deliveries will not be accepted during the first 24 hours following the trial's opening.**

### **JUMP HEIGHT CARDS & MEASURING**

Effective 1-1-2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Dogs without a valid jump height card/form may still compete, but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class. This measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. Dogs entered in the 24" height division are excepted from this requirement. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present, ALL dogs without a valid jump height card/form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure before the dog's first run of the trial. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running, and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. Judging will not be held up or interrupted for measuring! Please see "Instructions" section of the entry form.**

### **HEIGHT DIVISIONS**

**OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENTERING THE PROPER HEIGHT DIVISIONS. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes MUST jump in their measured division and are not allowed to jump higher or lower.**

### **PRIZES & AWARDS**

Rosettes (blue, red, yellow, white) will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height in each class. Green qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. MACH/PACH ribbons and bars will be awarded to dogs that earn their MACH/PACH title at these trials. The Guinness award will be awarded to dogs that earn their Novice A Standard or JWW title at these trials.

### **CONFIRMATIONS**

Anyone providing a legible email address will be notified of their status as soon as their entry is received. Final confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent to the email address provided - you will NOT receive a confirmation via U.S. Mail. If you do not provide an email address your confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be mailed to the address provided on the Official AKC entry form. All emailed correspondence will be acknowledged as soon as possible. **IF you do not receive an acknowledgement of a move-up or a withdrawal within 48 hours, please contact the Trial Secretary again. If you have not received a final confirmation of your entry five days before the show, contact the Trial Secretary.**

### **MOVE-UPS**

The Trial Secretary must receive move-ups by 6:00pm ET on Monday, April 20, 2020. Changes from Preferred to Regular Classes are not permitted after closing per AKC rules. Move-ups must be in writing (email is acceptable), NO TELEPHONE REQUESTS WILL BE HONORED. The following information must be provided: dog's call name, class currently entered, new class requested, owner's name and date. Day-to-day move-ups will be allowed provided the above information is given to the secretary at the trial site no later than 30 minutes after the final dog has run.

## **Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day**

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

### **Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)**

#### **FEO WILL BE OFFERED AT THIS TRIAL ON THURS, FRI, AND SAT ONLY**

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
  - Toys must be non-audible

- Toys may not leave the handler's hand
- Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

### **Fix and Go On (FNG)**

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
